

Prince William Sound Community College
Student Association Meeting Minutes
November 19, 2008

Meeting called to order at 1:40 pm in the Room 128, Valdez campus. 1. Approval of Minutes of Nov 5, 2008. Motion to approve the minutes by Makeah and seconded by Lizzy. Motion passed unanimously.
2. Old Business
 1. Motion to amend the amount needed for food for the Game Night activity held on Nov 13 to **\$130.00** made by Lizzy and seconded by Makeah. Motion passed unanimously.
 2. Motion to amend the amount expended by the MultiCultural Student Club for the International Foodfest. The amount originally approved was \$400. The amended amount is **\$456.27**. Motion to approve the additional \$56.27 made by Makeah and seconded by Lizzy. Motion passed unanimously.
 3. Motion to amend the amount needed to purchase the plaques for the Big Screen TV in the Residence Halls and the Information monitors from \$24.00 to **\$28.50** made by Makeah and seconded by Lizzy. The cost of shipping raised the initial price. Motion passed unanimously.
 4. The amount expended for the International Student Culture Exchange was **\$273.20** which had been originally approved for \$400.
 5. Motion to approve **\$900** for Finals Foods Week. Tuesday will feature grilled cheese sandwiches and soup (served by the gracious volunteers of the Student Services Department), Wednesday will feature a 6' Subway platter, Thursday will be Part-Time pizza and drinks (Types of pizza to be served: Hawaiian, Pepperoni, Cheese, Tomato and the always eatable "Munchy Monster", and the Friday finale will be the delicacies of Fu Kung. Motion made by Lizzy and seconded by Makeah. Motion passed unanimously.
 6. The recently completed student activities survey indicated a demand for Student Government to purchase a Wii game system. Emily S. has researched the different options for a Wii game system and will present her findings and recommendation at the next student government meeting on Wednesday, Nov 26th in the Instruction Boardroom at 1:30 pm.
